Schedule for Second Special Cut-Off

Colleges to approve eligible applicants under 2 nd Special Cut-Off	Till 5:00 pm 24 th Dec 2020 (Thur)
Last date of Payment against 2 nd Special Cut-Off	Till 11:59 pm 26 th Dec 2020 (Sat)

Guidelines for admission against 2nd Special Cut-Off

- (a) The vacant seats for each course + category in colleges will be displayed on the website of the University of Delhi by 10:00 am, 19th Dec 2020 (Sat). **The declared seats could vary in case some applicants cancel their admissions (thus increasing the seats) or some genuine grievances are addressed (thus decreasing the seats).**
- (b) The Cut-Off for various courses available under each category for a college who would be admitting students under 2nd Special Cut-Off will be available on the website of University of Delhi by 21st Dec 2020 (Mon).
- (c) Only those applicants will be considered who could not/ did not take admission in the initial announced Cut-Offs (including 1st Special Cut-Off and Special Drive) for whatsoever reasons.
- (d) Applicants who are already admitted (including NCWEB) in any course/ college of University of Delhi will not be eligible to participate in the 2nd special Cut-Off, that is, **movement of applicants will not be allowed.**
- (e) Applicants will apply to a single college + course. Applicants must ensure that they have carefully checked the number of seats vacant in the course + college they are applying to under their category.
- (f) In case the number of applicants applying for a particular course in a college is more than the number of seats available, colleges will make a merit as per the Best of Four/ Best of three required for the course. The college will approve only those number of applicants as per the merit, as the number of seats available.
- (g) In case of a tie for a seat the following tie-breaking rule shall be applied
 - a) The applicant with higher percentage of marks (aggregate of best five subjects including one language) in the qualifying examination will be considered first for admission.
 - b) The applicant with the earlier date of birth (as mentioned in class X certificate) will be considered for admission.
- (h) Merely applying under the 2nd Special Cut-Off does not guarantee an admission to the applicant.
- (i) No grievances will be entertained in case an applicant fails to apply or pay the fees (if approved) within the stipulated time period given in the schedule
- (j) Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD/KM/ Minority must be in possession of the stipulated caste or category documents (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD/KM/ Minority). **Under no circumstances extension/ additional time/ provision to fill undertaking/ affidavit will be provided to furnish any such documents.**
- (k) Applicants under OBC-NCL and EWS categories shall be considered based on the certificates issued **after March 31, 2020** only.
